PLEASE NOTE: SUBMISSION OF THIS APPLICATION, REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION, AND OTHER MATERIALS DOES NOT GUARANTEE YOUR DOG WILL BE ACCEPTED BY DRCI NOR DOES IT CONSTITUTE A CONTRACT BETWEEN YOU AND DRCI TO ACCEPT YOUR DOG. YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED OF THE STATUS OF YOUR APPLICATION AFTER ALL FORMS AND MATERIALS ARE RECEIVED AND REVIEWED BY DALMATIAN RESCUE OF COLORADO, INC.

To consider your request to surrender your Dalmatian, DRCI will need:

- 1) A complete copy of the vet records;
- 2) A rabies certificate dated within the last two and one half years;
- 3) If the dog is not current on vaccinations within the last three years, you MUST do this prior to surrender;
- 4) If the dog is not spayed/neutered, this will also be mandatory before we take possession or list the dog;
- 5) \$50.00 donation to list your dog on our website AND a \$100.00 donation to actually take your dog. Both donations are tax deductible. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

If DRCI agrees to accept your dog, you will need to provide the following at the time of actual surrender:

- 1) a large bag of Avoderm Chicken & Rice dog food;
 - 2) dog toys (if any);
 - 3) collar and leash;
 - 4) crate if he/she uses it;
 - 5) dog bowls.
- These items help us help your dog and will make the transition a little less stressful for your dog.

In addition to the above items, to place your dog on our web site and increase the chance of finding a new forever home, please provide the following:

- 1) Several appealing or pleasant digital photos. Show the dog's good side and make him/her desirable.

- 2) Attach a full written description of your dog's good points, faults, habits and needs, and the type of home you'd like it to have.

DRCI is not always able to take your dog from an area shelter, so it is best to work with us before surrendering your dog to the shelter. Dying in a shelter (very great possibility if the dog is not under 5 yrs of age, able to pass a very stringent evaluation, is not far, and is very healthy) is a horrible way to end a life... scared, abandoned and alone. Please speak with us before you take your dog to a shelter. We generally cannot take owner surrenders, but if we have a foster home we will consider taking your dog.
