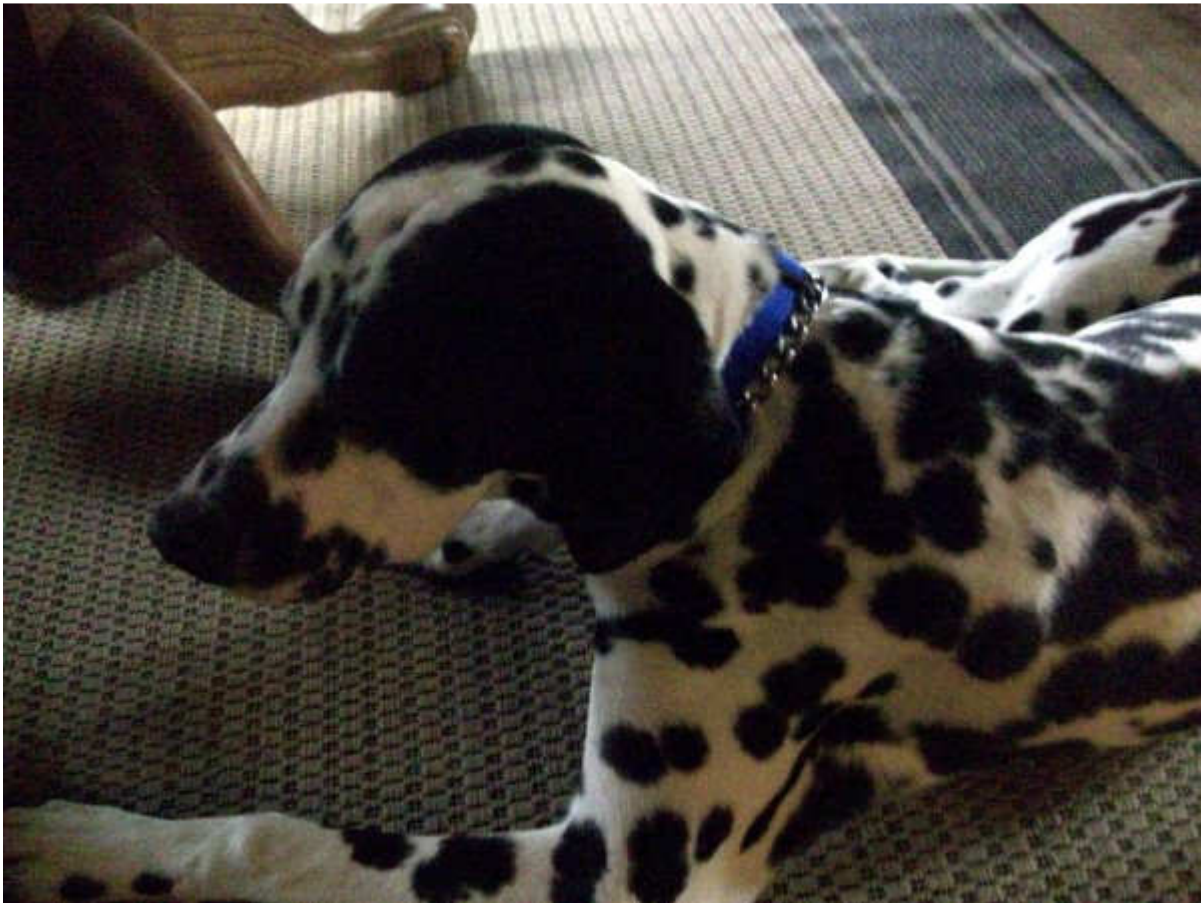


Patrick

I have sent some pictures so you can see how well I am doing.

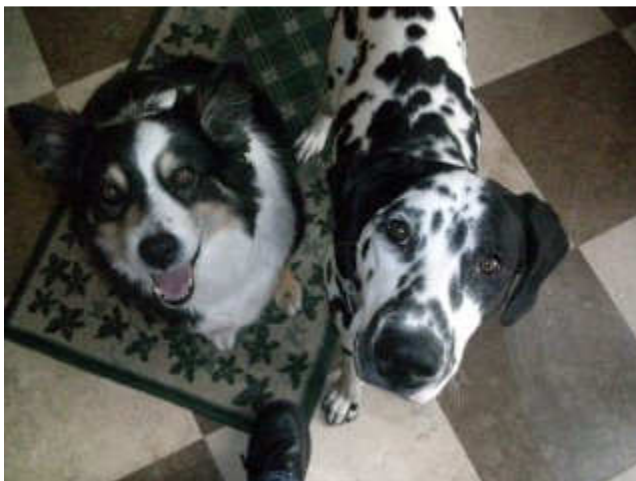

P. S. I was adopted on St. Patrick's Day... and my name is Patrick. How cool is that??!!!

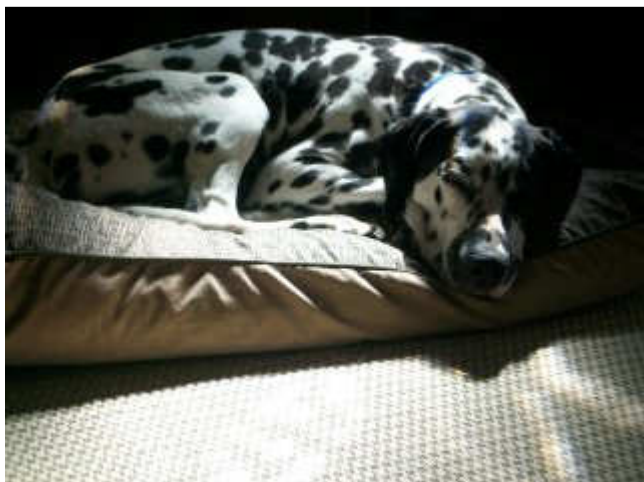
