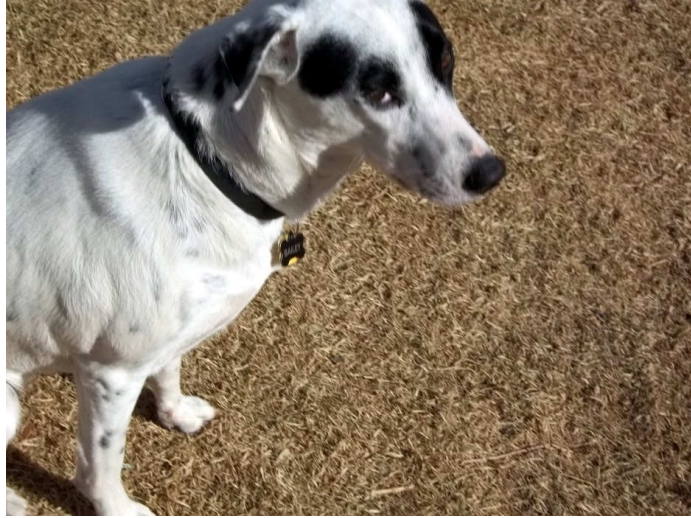


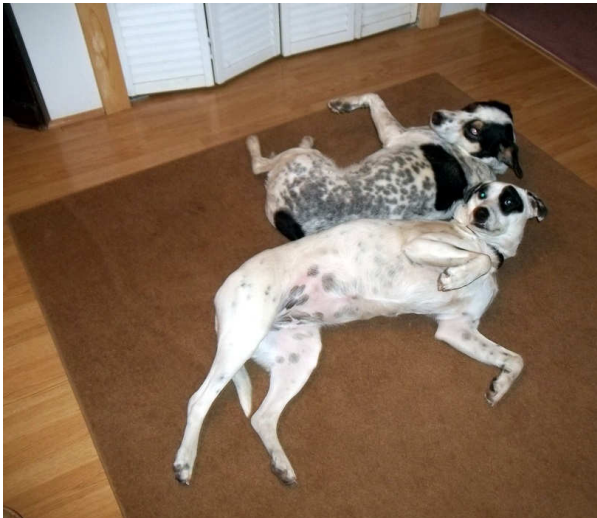
Bailey

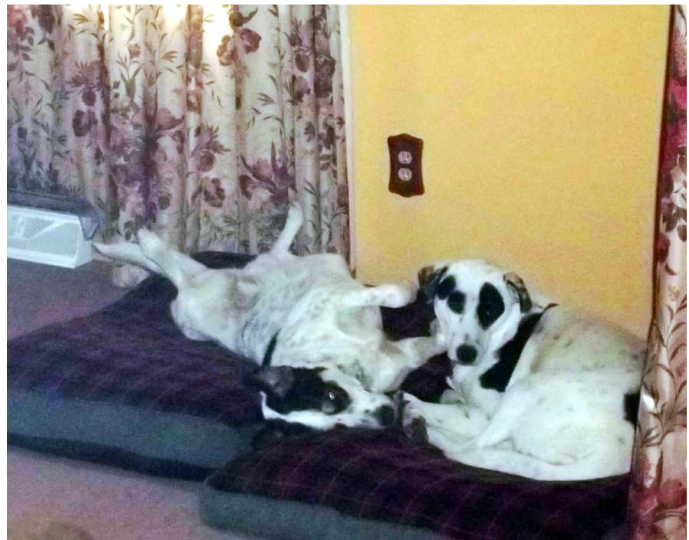
Bailey and Bree playing on the floor.

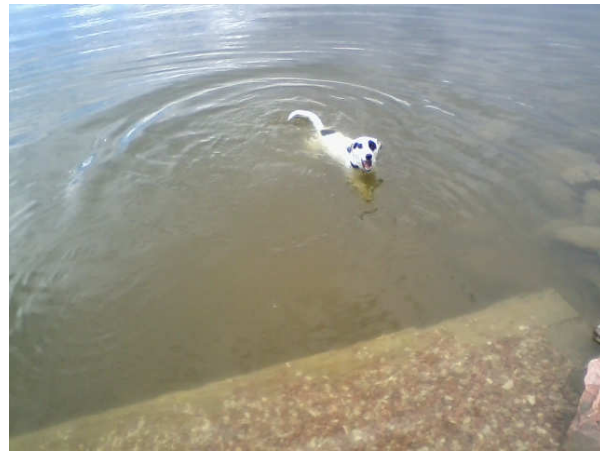
It's hard to sleep with a foot in my ear!!!!
